Effective with January 2015:

The associate degree requirement was implemented for students to qualify to take the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) exam as of January 2015. Therefore, RMH School of Radiography requires **an associate degree or higher prior to begin the program.** The pre-requisites must also be completed as part of the degree or, if not taken at the time of degree completion, must be in addition to the degree.
