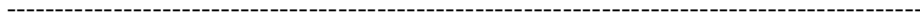

WHAT IS THE INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM (IEP)?

The Intensive English Program (IEP) is designed to help non-native English speakers prepare for and transition to further education at Rock Valley College. The IEP is for advanced level ELA (ESL) students.

NOTE: ELA is English Language Acquisition (formerly - English as a Second Language or ESL).

FULL TIME IEP PROGRAM

In the full-time IEP, students complete coursework in grammar, writing, reading strategies, listening, speaking, and vocabulary development. This is a 15-week, full-time program, the cost of \$504 per class (books extra).

Spring semester: January - May

INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM FAQs

Academic Expectations

Successful students attend every class session. Students need to be prepared to spend additional time completing homework, readings, and projects, as well as preparing for tests. However, students do not earn academic credit for coursework.

Payment Information

Payment for an IEP class is due before starting class. No financial aid or assistance is available. A payment plan will be explained at the required orientation.

How Do I Know if I Qualify to Join the IEP?

Interested advanced students must reserve a seat at one of the testing sessions. There is no cost to be tested. Testing lasts approximately two hours. Serious students who demonstrate strong skills in all areas of English are invited to participate in the IEP.

What Happens if I am Accepted into the IEP?

After you have been tested and accepted into the IEP, you will be required to attend an IEP Information/Orientation Session. Additional program details, enrollment procedures, and payment requirements will be explained, and you will have time to ask any questions about the program. Students opting for the payment plan will need to pay \$100 at orientation.

What Happens if I am NOT Accepted into the IEP?

Students who are not accepted into the IEP are strongly encouraged to enroll in Rock Valley College's public ELA (ESL) classes in order to strengthen their listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. They can re-test for the IEP in future semesters.
